Herbert White, MBA, serves as interim chief financial officer of Temple University Health System, a \$1.9 billion academic health enterprise in Philadelphia. White oversees financial reporting and planning, business intelligence, treasury, government and payer strategy, revenue cycle, medical records, and appeals. During his tenure at Temple, White has played a leadership role in nine acquisitions and five start-ups and collaborated on the consolidation of four companies, divestiture of three, and closure of two.

White chairs Philadelphia International Medicine, serves on the finance committee and board of Health Partners Plans, and serves on the board of Temple University Health System's Center for Population Health; Core Solutions Inc., a behavioral health electronic health record company; and Philadelphia's Korean Cultural Foundation.
